📊 What is ASM?

ASM is a surveillance mechanism used to monitor and control the trading of securities exhibiting unusual patterns. It involves staged actions based on real-time risk assessment.

📌 ASM Stages Explained

Stage Details

- Stage 1 Identification of securities based on predefined risk criteria, such as sudden spikes in price or trading volume.
- Stage 2 Imposition of preventive controls like tighter price bands, increased margin requirements, or disclosure obligations.
- Stage 3 Ongoing surveillance and review to check for continued irregularities or new risk indicators.
- Stage 4Modification or removal of surveillance measures depending on the security's
performance and market behavior.
- **Stage 5** Continuous monitoring and re-adjustment to maintain orderly market conditions and safeguard investors.

ITM & OTM – Options Trading Terminology

While not directly related to ASM, many traders monitor ITM/OTM options in volatile stocks often under surveillance.

• ITM (In The Money)

- **Call Option**: Strike Price < Current Market Price \rightarrow Profitable if exercised.
- ∘ **Put Option**: Strike Price > Current Market Price → Profitable if exercised.
- OTM (Out of The Money)
 - **Call Option**: Strike Price > Current Market Price \rightarrow Not profitable to exercise.
 - **Put Option**: Strike Price < Current Market Price \rightarrow Not profitable to exercise.

These terms help traders evaluate risk and return when options are linked to volatile or ASM-listed stocks.
